Some love it like crack. Others hate it with a questionable passion. But everyone goes at one time or another, because, well ... it's the Black Gay Cheers. It's that homey, down to earth haven where everybody knows your name—and, for that matter, your pain as well.

In the relatively short time since it opened, Chi Chiz has become ground-zero for the Black Gay community. Though there are other establishments throughout New York and even across the Hudson in Jersey, Chi Chiz is the hub of our ultra-diverse community. Known for its addictive fire-cracker hot wings, two-for-one happy hours extending from 5 to 9pm (and all day on Sunday), karaoke nights, card games, pool tournaments and—last but not least—it's endless parade of hot boy flesh. It is the first destination for travelers looking for Black Gay flavor in the city that never sleeps—a city, which arguably, sits at the center of the world.

"We've been here eight and a half years," said Ronelle, co-owner of Chi Chiz, "We opened June 28th, 1998." With a shock of purple hair down one side of her face, she gives off ex-rock-chick with a splash of Camryn Manheim intensity. I immediately knew two things about her—the lady knows how to have a good time, and if I ever really got on her bad side, she'd flatten me first and ask questions later. I just love a woman like that.

I didn't like Chi Chiz at first, I admitted when I sat down to interview her and Mark (another co-owner) in their cramped, subterranean office several levels beneath the bar. I was a Two Potato regular then, and thought it was competition for my usual watering hole.

"Well it was!" Ronelle said, with a hearty laugh.

Ronelle and Mark are white, and though the third owner (Alex) is black, I had to ask: Why a Black Gay bar? It was Mark who answered, "We never wanted it to be a white bar or a black bar. I just wanted to open this bar. It was my dream for years to do that. As things started coming together, I'd known Ronelle for a long time and asked her to be involved. Then I brought Alex in, who I'd also known for a long time. There was supposed to be a fourth partner, but that didn't work out."

As it turned out, Alex (a well-liked figure in the community, known for his smooth dread-

locked Caribbean style) brought his following from a former legendary Black Gay hang-out, Keller's. And then Curtis—a gangly and gregarious, quick-witted bartender and also part-time drag performer known as Rachel Harmony—absconded from Two Potato just down the block and became one of Chi Chiz first bartenders, bringing his loyal customers with him. After that, Chi Chiz was off and running and it hasn't stopped since.

"I remember the first time I met Curtis. He had green hair," Ronelle said. "He was so worried that we were gonna tell him that he had to dye it back. But then he walked in and saw my hair and said, 'Oh, thank God!'"

Was your hair always purple? I asked.

"At that time it was pink, but I changed it like 6 months after we opened."

"Curtis and I had a lot of fun back then," Mark added with a sparkle in his eye, because Curtis has since passed away. "He came in all full and life and energy, joking around behind the bar; those long arms of his were always breaking things. But I'd go home and my stomach would hurt from laughing all day. Curtis was the best."

I couldn't agree more. Curtis—who I knew very well and loved very much—with his snooty Bermuda accent and acid wit, was truly one of a kind.

I asked Ronelle what her best Chi Chiz memory was. "We were in legal battles for several years. So I think, yeah, my happiest memory was when we didn't have to deal with the landlord anymore, and it was ours and it was legal and that was that."

And there are lots of battles on Christopher St. The Pier (now gentrified into Hudson River Park), and the village in general has been a haven for Gay youth since I can remember; a place where you came to feel safe from a homophobic world, where you wouldn't be harassed or beat-up for being different. But in recent years though, the 'Pier kids' have been blamed for causing numerous problems with the newer, upscale, more 'family-oriented' village residents.

Comedian/Actor Darryl Hill, a Jersey City resident and Chi Chiz's own 'Norm', had this to say to the new complaining Village residents who

don't want their kids exposed to certain things, "You know, when you moved here there were dicks in the store-front windows. Now you wanna bitch about it?"

I wondered if any of that drama spilled into Chi Chiz, and asked if they had any problems with the neighbors. "A little bit," Mark said. "Our customers stay inside; those kids are outside all day. Even though some of our customers mingle with them, the Village has always been this way. But now, because the kids are mostly Black and Hispanic, they're making big waves about it. It's ridiculous. But it doesn't really affect us. And the police respect us."

"At least now, in the beginning it wasn't easy," Ronelle added. "It's a lot better now. We thought we knew everything in the beginning. We learned by experience I guess."

Then I remembered a rumor—Is it true that Will, from Will & Grace, lives upstairs over the bar?

"He lived next door for a little awhile," Mark said, "He rented it while he was doing a play."

Ronelle laughed, "He'd walk out the door and everybody would go, 'Are you really gay?' He's like, 'No, sorry!'"

I expressed skepticism, but Mark clarified, "Well, his wife and kid were with him."

"He's just a good actor." Ronelle said, quashing my suspicions.

I'd always thought working in a gay bar would be totally cool, sorta like a work and play thing all mingled together. I'd taken the short PATH train ride over to do the interview (the train station is right next to the bar) with Vincent, another Jersey City resident and long-time doorman/bouncer for Chi Chiz. An imposing figure, when I asked if he was going to work or just to hang out, he quickly informed me that the bar was the last place he wanted to be on his day off. When I told Mark this he said, "At first they wanna be here 24/7. But then they either get fired for being here too much and getting into trouble, or they get lives outside of here and last much longer."

So much for my working in a gay bar fantasy. Such a sex-charged environment would surely get me into trouble. A recent employee—a slinky, exotic boy named Megnahd (a Hindi name)—posed for a picture while yawning and complaining about the long night he'd had. He

seemed sweet and intriguing. I hope he doesn't get into any trouble. But if he does though, I hope he does it with me.

As for the regular clientele, young and old, Mark had this to say. "They come after work, enjoy the happy hour, eat, have their friends around them, they gossip and chit-chat and it's just like their extended family. A lot of people come here from other places and they don't have their own families close by so they kinda adopt a bar family."

After the interview, I went back upstairs to the bar. The walls were lined with Chi Chiz latest monthly art exhibit, this one from a talented local Black Gay artist named Derrick Bell. The crowd had grown. Beyoncé blared from the speakers. Four guys squabbled in a back corner over their Spades game. So much color and diversity surrounded me. A possible millionaire in a slick Armani suit sipping a brown cocktail stood to my right ... while a possible street hustler—a young, brooding, sexy thing with pants sagging so low I spied his perfectly round, boxer-clad ass—sipped a Corona to my left. Mark was right. This was an extended family, my extended family, with all the winners and losers and intellectuals and crazies and saints and sluts inherent in any such group. Under the skin, we all shared similar experiences as same-gender-loving Black men in a crazy homophobic world hell-bent on tearing us down. Where else would I wanna be?

Relaxed now and feeling at home, I settled by the pool table to play. Jarrod—the resident wannabe pool shark—announced loudly, "Okay, Taylor's ready to get his ass kicked too!"

In pool, as in Spades, talking shit is a prerequisite. "You kick my ass? Please. Only if you get me drunk first and poke my eye out." We gave each other a brotherly hug and exchanged pleasantries, before he commenced to ... well, kicking my ass off the table like he promised.

It was all good though. Plus, there's nothing like losing to family. But next time, family or no family, that Jarrod bitch is going down. Believe that. — www.TaylorSiluwe.com

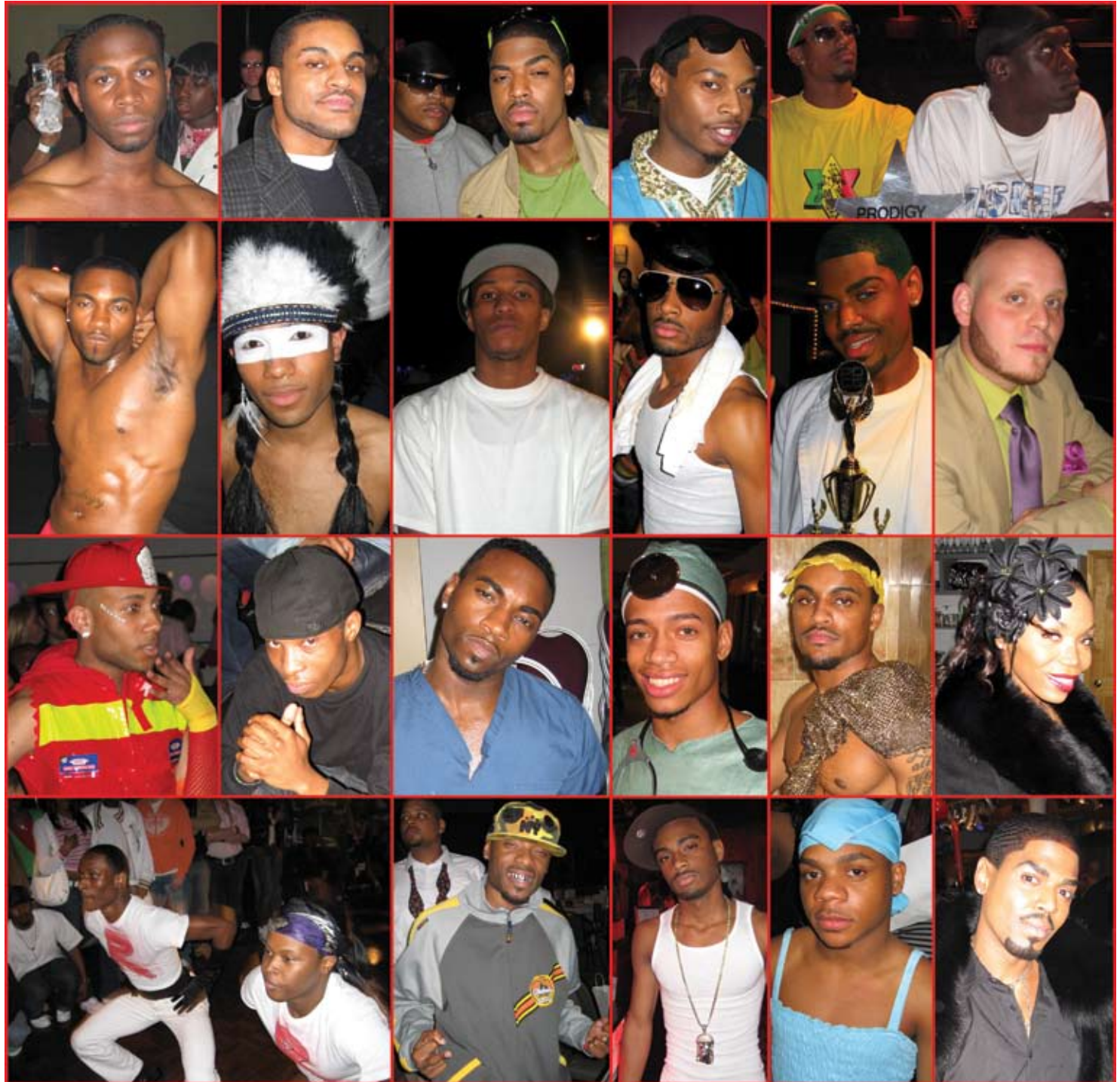

RACISM & SEXISM IN MUSIC? The Don Imus (who) scandal...

"Hip-hop is a worldwide cultural phenomena that transcends race and doesn't engage in racial slurs," Russell Simmons said Friday (April 13) at his Hip-Hop Summit Action Network. Al Sharpton, who himself has made many racist remarks, has been quite outspoken on the issue relating to music, but on Friday, Sharpton clarified his position to MTV News by saying, "We have for a while said to the hip-hop community that we believe in free speech, but at the same time, we also have the right to say this whole sexist, racist overuse of the word 'n---a' and 'ho' we need to deal with in our community." "We need to deal with how there are many artists that are conscious and progressive that can't get a [recording] contract. So this is nothing new. Two years ago at the National Action Network Convention, we had that conversation. This Saturday at the National Action Network Convention, we will have the conversation about what we do about the violence and the [racist], sexist language in hip-hop. At one of the first Hip-Hop Summits in 2000, we talked about this. I think a lot of the elements in hip-hop are positive and for us. I think some are bad"

Don Imus got fired because of many comments not just the most recent. Just GOOGLE him and you'll find many. I would hope that we place our anger in the proper direction and go even higher.

Think about what you listen to on a daily basis. How it makes you feel, and what it makes you want to do. Do the words of Common or Kanye West make you want to hit someone? How about Nelly's "Playa" or " Hot In Here," does it make u want to sweat? Words are powerful. Even Tyra Banks had her say with a recent show about Gay's in Hip Hop. My favorite moment was when the straight rapper AJAXX said to the Gay panel that they will never make it because of their appearance and/or commercial financial backing.

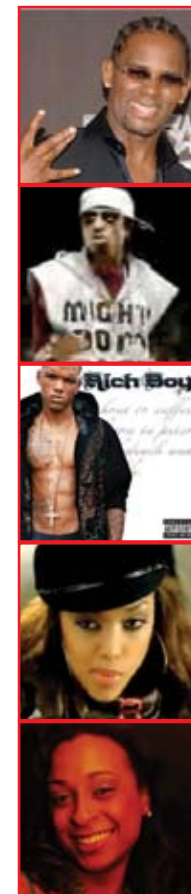
"The hood just won't respect you," he said. Keith Boykin, a respected journalist spoke to the point that everything we wear is drag and he was so tired of people equating a strong Black Man with wearing Hi Ho Drag. Just because you wear your pants showing your ass that's supposed to make you straight and acceptable? So you see it's not

just words that make statements about who we are. I often feel while playing Hip-Hop at the clubs, that I am a dealer of sorts. "Walk It Out" is not claimed by anyone to be a thinking mans record ... lol. But the whole point sometimes is to lose yourself and escape the drama of the world. So isn't there enough room for all of it? Don't we need minimalist party tracks that brag about the cash and hoes? There are rappers that have alot of cash, and alot of hoes get with them for it. Ultimately that is the difference -Hip-Hop has no need to explain itself regarding its lyrics, there really is no comparison of the Don Imus story to be made.

A conversation with Alex Flex on the CocoDorm controversy

In December '06 an anonymous delivery was made throughout a Florida neighborhood. Thrown from a passing car, it landed on dew misted lawns like the morning news. But this was no Daily Bugle. The unsolicited package contained black gay cyber-porn materials and a letter directing their attention to what they call a "whore house" in the neighborhood where it was being produced and uploaded to the internet. Although the package contained scandalous allegations of past wrongdoing—even a DVD of a fight caught on the many cameras inside the house—no neighbors came knocking.

On April 18th 2007, Jeff Burnside and an NBC6 news crew did knock on the door of the Miami house. Known to its internet subscribers as CocoDorm—where a handful of ever changing young 'models' do indeed engage in sexual acts for the camera—it's been described as an internet reality show, with sex.

On May 07th the NBC6 news team arrived again as city inspectors issued 5 citations to CocoDorm, taping a notice on the door. A local news special aired the following night titled The House Next Door, which delved into the aforementioned events and begged the question—would you want this house next door to your kids?

In light of the 11th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals decision in 2001 supporting Voyeur Dorm—a Tampa dorm-style internet business much like CocoDorm but with women residents—that Florida's city code "cannot be applied to a location that does not, itself, offer adult entertainment to the public," gay bloggers picked up the story and an internet firestorm began. Previous CocoDorm news stories resurfaced—including a 2006 Chicago Health Department report which noted a high rate of HIV infection in the dorm which hailed from Chicago at the time—and other allegations against the dorm's parent company, Flava Works, and its owner Phil Bleicher.

Flava Works issued this statement:

"We have been a "condom only" company since even before our move to Miami and the often cited "RawThugs" is a series that has long been discontinued. While the Chicago's Department of Health may sound damning, let us clar-

ify that first of all, as sad as it is, these numbers are in line with national averages. Also, models that tested positive for STDs were forbidden to participate in any sort of sexual group activity and were usually sent home. The discovery of the model/applicant's STD status were the result of the application process, once the test results are known, the model is sent home and not permitted to work. We test our models and Chicago decided to punish us for it. The only reason the city knew about any of the infections was because we voluntarily test our prospective models and the results are automatically reported. Models usually stay only 30 days at the dorm, but HIV can stay dormant for months. How can we be responsible for any of these infections? The Chicago report fails to mention that these infections are of people who are APPLYING to be a CocoDorm model.

"As for CocoDorm Miami ... Flava Works is preparing to file a motion to dismiss the citations and aggressively fight the city and NBC6 on these erroneous allegations. Finally, another blogger, Keith Boykin, has chosen to attack the company instead of fighting for free speech and expression. As you know, two bloggers, Jasmine Cannick and Bernard J. Tarver willingly and knowingly posted an HIV/STD story next to a picture of three CocoDorm Models, and in so doing implied that the models where HIV/STD positive. Flava Works sent a DMCA notice claiming that the images they used are copyright protected. We did not try to silence them, why would we encourage our members in a blog post to voice their support if we wanted the blogs shut down? They simply choose to ignore the danger their implications were causing and their own webhost took action. If you read Keith Boykin's blog, you will see no mention of the real issue - that the media and city are trying to regulate what a person does in their own home, but instead, they focus on allegations of HIV & STD's."

In a conversation with Alex Flex, Dorm Manager and former model for CocoDorm, we discussed the current drama over this enterprise in a residential neighborhood, and about that mysterious package which started it all.

On the mysterious package ...

Taylor Siluwé — It was an anonymous package though?

Alex Flex — Yes.

TS — And it had some porn stuff in it?

AF — Yeah, pretty much. Not necessarily a porno movie, but enough of the website to know that porn was being made. The images were not meant for minors. They were delivering them to everyone's house, saying that the reason the porn was in the package was to show what was going on inside the house. The person that delivered this was throwing them from the inside of a car so that it lands on the lawn, just like you're delivering a news paper. But if you're doing this to prevent children from seeing it, then don't throw it on the front lawn of someone's house.

TS — In Jeff Burnside's report he said the cops were called to the house four times since September.

AF — That was false. The cops were only called twice.

TS — So, they were there just twice and that was for that fight?

AF — Yeah. That was the only reason they came to the house was because of that fight, which is normal. Somebody has a fight, a third party is gonna call the cops—which is what cops are for. Isn't that what goes on in normal life? To build on that same point, four or five times since I've been here, they've completely shut down the block in pursuit of whichever criminal they were chasing that day. I wanna send you some pictures of the surrounding area because in the broadcast they show me looking out the window. But you would assume that it's a front window, when in fact that window over looks two lots in succession. They're like abandoned lots where there's trash and God's knows what else out there.

On Bloggers, Exploitation, and the Black/White Thing

Alex Flex — Thing is, there's no direct mention of what the story is actually about. People are shaming these boys, putting them down and making them look like monsters. And for something that most of them watch.

TS — A lot of the black gay leaders seem to have a problem with Flava Works because its owned by a white person.

AF — For the major companies, percentage wise, how many are owned and run by white owners? And once again, a desperate cling to some sort of argument that can band everybody behind it. And yes, issues like racism and comparisons to the Tuskegee Project are to get black people to stand behind it. We're constantly defending, defending, defending that we're practicing safe sex and we're ensuring that these guys are abiding by this rule of pro-

tection in the house. But nobody's pulling up these other websites, which are 'black owned' that are producing movies now ... depicting raw sex or bare-back sex. I challenge people, find out when our last production of a raw sex video was made in comparison to these sites you're supporting because they're "black owned and operated", and look at they're production of raw movies. I mean, recent movies. The Double standards are being thrown around while the real facts are being hidden. And once the facts get hidden, that's it.

TS — They are dredging up Flava Works dirt and dressing up the new charges as the same thing.

AF — We blame the news team for doing a story like this. There's way too much they ensue that allows for implication and assumptions, and now—boom, five black guys are labeled. That's it. You can't take that back. In the newscast, I'm in the window looking out. From John Doe's point of view—he's looking out his front window and he's just standing in his underwear just doing whatever [for all to see]. But in fact, the window I'm looking out faces vacant lots.

TS — By saying you're having sex "in full view" and showing a picture of someone taking off his shirt, they're painting a fictitious picture?

AF — Exactly.

TS — They gave you five citations, the first was the illegal rooming house.

AF — They say there is a law in Miami that no more than three people who are not related can live in the house at the same time. But we've spoken to our lawyer and he's assured us that if the guys who are staying at the dorm aren't receiving mail and aren't paying rent to be there, then they're not legally residents of the dorm.

TS — What about operating an "adult" business in a residential neighborhood?

AF — The lawyer assured us that a residential area won't want an adult company working in the neighborhood because of the foot traffic and the customers. But the dorm itself doesn't have customers coming by.

TS — The Supreme court refused to hear the appeal against Voyeur Dorm whose neighbors tried to oust them too. So as it stands now, it's not a 'normal' adult business. It's in virtual space.

AF — Right, it's not a strip club or a sex club. People aren't coming to the dorm to watch these sex shows.

TS — At least they weren't, until the media swooped in and now everybody knows where it is.

AF — Now there are people whose lives could be in danger. On those blogs was talk about burning down the house; should we take these blogs seriously? Yes! They have the address.

TS — You should take it very seriously. What about the ‘failure to maintain a lot in safe clean conditions’ citation?

AF — I have pictures of the day of the citation. It’s hard to understand, what exactly are these conditions? What exactly is unsafe? It’s not specific; it’s not saying ‘pavement uneven’ or ‘step broken’, it’s just unsafe. Well, what exactly is unsafe? If these citations are put here for us to review and then fix, why wouldn’t you be specific about these unsafe conditions? It’s a broad thing.

TS — Did you talk to the people who issued the citations?

AF — The people responsible for issuing the citations are more so trying to convince the landlord to evict us rather than explain these citations. They find these little loopholes ... the exact same loopholes they used to use to throw off black businesses on bullshit claims.

TS — So basically it’s a witch hunt?

AF — A publicity stunt. They needed a shot of some citation, so the news station incited this whole inspection. They went down and got the inspectors to come and look and find and document, you know, all of these wrongdoings.

TS — So have you ever talked to Jeff Burnside again?

AF — The lawyer advised us not to because his stance wouldn’t be unbiased. Now he’s gotta protect himself. He can’t just say, you know, ‘Okay I was wrong, my bad.’ It’s not gonna happen like that. I actually spoke to another black Blogger and I told him straight out that my main concern is these guys are put into this light of “demoralizing an entire neighborhood simply because they’re having sex with each other.” He said “Yeah, I agree with you. I just want the facts on both sides.” And the next day he posts this Chicago story and makes claims to know that four dorm models are HIV positive. And then he posts several pictures ... with the claim of four models, which leaves anyone who’s reading this post to figure out who’s got it. So not only are you saying these dorm models have HIV, but now you’ve got a set of pictures to see which dorm models you’re talking about.

TS — I posted on my blog about the whole situation.

AF — I read your blog ... it was one of the few blogs that painted an entire picture. You didn’t side with Flava Works and you didn’t side with the community, you gave facts. You know— here are the facts, now it’s time to make a decision on how you view the situation. When you put both sides, both facts, the fact somebody was accused and later the charges are dropped with prejudice [referring to charges in Illinois the Flava Works owner, Bleicher, had amassed 3 million with a bogus charity], which means that not only where these charges dropped but also these charges can’t be brought up again. So

that tells you even more.

TS — And Boykin, being a lawyer, should know not to frame new charges with old allegations which have already been dropped. I actually brought up that fact on his blog. He hasn’t responded.

AF — They never do.

TS — When did the dorm first open in Miami?

AF — August 15, 2006.

TS — Since the Chicago allegations, what different things have you done as far as safe sex practices, and uh, being proactive in that department?

AF — We’ve instituted a stricter application process, ‘cause obviously every one we’ve used has a loophole, or, no fail-safe ... and we end up taking the brunt end of it. So not only do you have to take an STD/HIV test when you arrive in Florida, you also have to provide one during the application process before you can even be considered. We’re doing what we can, having educational pamphlets and information out in the open ... buckets of condoms, with, you know, messages that say ‘use a condom, save your life’. It’s not like it’s mentioned once and you never hear it again. There are constant reminders that this is a ‘Safe-Sex Environment’... In the real world there is no controlled environment, there’s no mandate of safe sex. These guys don’t wanna die. They know HIV/AIDS kills, and gonorrhea and syphilis maim and destroy your life, so, these guys aren’t trying to contract these diseases. We’re vigilant in our testing and we’re vigilant with our education. Those are the two main things that are gonna stop the disease. Not the blame game, and, you know, the exploitation angle.

TS — So have you had any other difficulties between the time you opened and now?

AF — No, none at all.

TS — So it’s always been cool with the neighbors?

AF — Exactly, even before I arrived ... they moved here in 2006, August, and it’s been all that time since there’s been a mention of the dorm. As far as safe sex practices, check out the site, check out the feed. Is the dorm producing any raw videos? No!

TS — People are fascinated with the dorm just like they’re fascinated with sex. Either they love it or they hate it, and they can’t figure out why they hate it — but they just do.

AF — I wonder, I mean, with the blog community, is it that these guys are so open with their sexuality and that they’re not ashamed of it? Is this why they’re putting them down for it? Well, I want the world to know that we’re not ashamed of what we do. We’re not doing anything wrong. We’re not hurting anyone. We’re simply acting out the fantasies that you are afraid to act on.

NORMAN WAKEFIELD

An Interview by Lenox Magee

Model, actor, and full-time college student Norman Wakefield gives Flavalife a rare look inside another man's pain. After losing his daughter, he found strength through music and modeling to continue on. Now, Norman reveals a life without his daughter and how focusing on music and modeling has allowed him to move on.

LENOX: Your main focus is modeling and singing. When did you start writing your own music?

NORMAN: Music has always been a passion. I've always written music since I was younger and I still write my music to this day. It gives me a way to express my feelings and basically [through my music] I'm trying to put across a message to the industry that males hurt just as much as females. What we're lacking in the industry; males aren't expressing their feelings. We're brushing your shoulders off but I'm trying to come out with the feel that we have feelings too.

LENOX: Was there a recent experience that made you feel compelled enough to speak out about male affection?

NORMAN: Yes. Recently I've been through a lot of pain. I had a daughter but then I found that she wasn't mine. A lot of people didn't understand how I felt, to have someone taken from you like that. I'm still in her life because I want to be, because I love her, but my heart is beyond being crushed and apart of it will never be replaced and it's impossible for it to ever be replaced. It's sort of like someone dying but still being there; it's almost unbelievable.

LENOX: How are you moving on from this experience through your music?

NORMAN: I'm handling it because I'm not a weak person but I express myself through music. My music takes over and takes the pain away from me, from my heart. I try not to dwell on it too much because I don't want to be brought down in the process. I got to let it pass and deal with it. I wrote two or three songs regarding the dilemma. The songs are basically me asking why me, why us. I gave it the feel that I was worried about myself, I worried her, and I was worried about everybody that has to go through this situation. I'm replacing my broken heart through singing, modeling, and acting. I don't regret going through this experience, it's made me a better person.

LENOX: Are there any particular music groups that you look up too and wish to work with in the future?

NORMAN: I'm working on my CD right now. I'm going into the studio to work with H-Town, Sonya Townsend, and, a new up and coming female rapper, Ex2c. The group H-Town is really an inspirational group for me. This groups gives the feel that love is still out there and that's what I want to add to my music. I don't want to corrupt the love life of anybody and I don't want make it seem like if you're living and your loving it's going to go wrong, but if you're living and you're loving be careful but still go in that direction; it's worth a try. H-Town reminds me, and a lot people, that love is still out there and that's why I look up to them.

LENOX: Going through all of this, do you still believe in love?

NORMAN: I definitely still believe in love. I don't believe that the girl who put me through this situation didn't love me. I think we're unable to not love but we just fight it. I don't believe it's possible to not love someone. I don't know where I would be without poetry or music.
