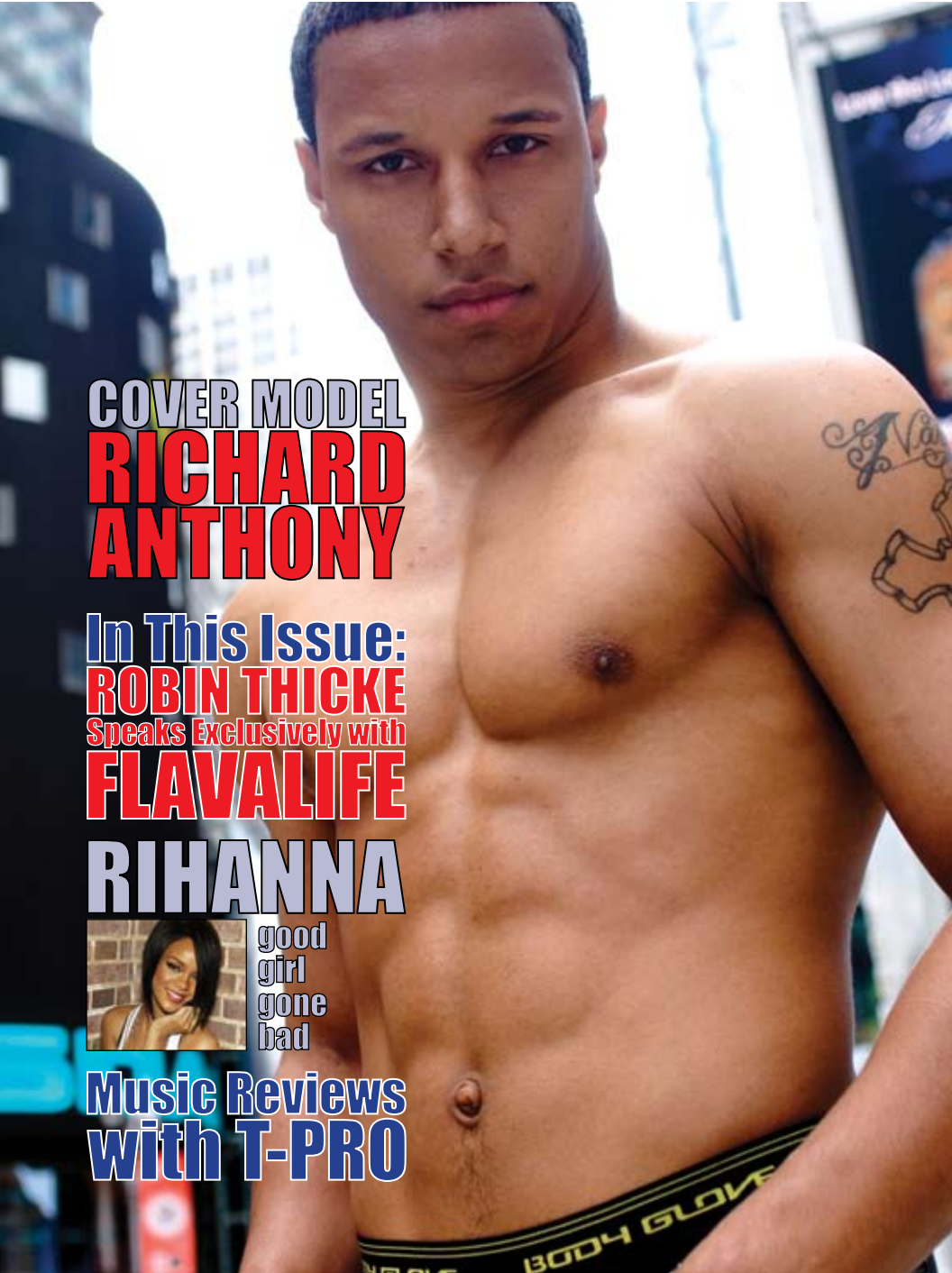

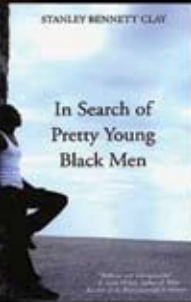
CRUISIN' WITH STANLEY BENNETT CLAY

There ain't nothing sexier than a man with a book. If you think it's nerdy, then you just don't know.

My love affair with author Stanley Bennett Clay began with *In Search of Pretty Young Black Men*. I took the provocative title on my birthday cruise last year. Between peaceful moments staring at the Caribbean Sea, I was enraptured by the tale of Dorian Moore, "... a mysterious and seductive young man who provides comfort to the moneyed, the neglected, the lost, and the lonely in an elegant hilltop community in southern California." Ooh, a hot hustler boy—just my flava.

But it was the title that caught me; I ordered it without knowing a thing about Stanley Bennett Clay. Maybe because I realized that my life has been a search for pretty young black men ever since I was one—and also, that until the day I die they'll have the heart-stopping ability to bring a smile to my face, a tingle to my nuts, and make me play the biggest fool. Yeah. The good ones can.



As I read and sun-bathed and enjoyed the pleasant rocking of the ship, I peeked over my shades at the most adorable sight. A real, live, pretty young black man (who'd only been old enough to drink for ten minutes) sauntered by looking edible, dangerous and darkly Brazilian in his Speedo. To my delight, he set up a deck chair next to mine; giving a show involving slow applications of oil and a few seductive stretches. He asked what I was reading, and a few 151 Coladas later, we were the best of friends.

He reminded me of Stanley Bennett Clay's character, Dorian Moore—the hot hustler who drove some residents of the rich black enclave of Baldwin Hills to lascivious and murderous distraction—and I had to admit that lust for such heavenly creatures can do exactly that.

"...Was he a god, or was he just another piece of trade? Maybe Dorian Moore was one and the same; after all, gods and trade both provide comfort. The cannibalizing of Dorian Moore, and morsels like him, will continue. It is the law of nature that these are grown for the nourishment of others."

Halle-fuckin'-lujah. You gotta love nature. And reading *In Search of Pretty Young Black Men* was kinda like being ravaged by that hot young Brazilian ... well, almost. But that's another story for another day.

For this year's cruise I ordered his latest novel—*Looker*. Yeah, it's my new ritual now, vacationing with a hot book by a same gender loving author who knows my cravings, and my pain. Unfortunately I couldn't wait for the cruise and I delved into it the moment it arrived.

Brandon Heywood and Omar Stevens were the best of friends since childhood. 'Brando' is a handsome, popular, and successful entertainment lawyer; a man whose seemingly idyllic life lacks passion. Choosing to remain celibate for 2 years after the end of a long term relationship, he goes through life quietly on the sidelines. Omar, a showbiz writer and



journalist, thrashes through life and love all the while hiding feelings for Brando kept hidden since they were teenagers. Soon, rape and murder throw Brando and Omar up against some harsh realities in a world where everything is not as it seems.

At its core, *Looker* is a love story of sorts. Yet it has all the wonderfully voyeuristic dark eroticism of its predecessor.

"Whenever Omar and Andrew got together they got right down to business ... Burberry briefs and cheap polyester boxers would be stomped off to the ground. They would suck on nipples like newborns; take to dick like the bottle. Hot breath would heat up both pairs of balls; and Omar's tongue, with decades of experience, would play gently around the soft, trim hairs that encircled the sweet smiling young pucker.

"Young stallion legs would hoist up and spread young ass for old dick that now begged for a ride with a quiver, and young ass would oblige with the joy of the pain that only good, deep penetration brings."

Awesome. But it's much more than just sex. Stanley Bennett Clay's intricate tales flow, excite and educate on the high-seas and off, making his work a must-have in the travel bag of every pretty young black man of substance, and those of us who, well, just wanna get into the briefs of one. I'll bring it on my cruise anyway, waiting for the next pretty young 'looker' to ask me what I'm reading. 'Cause like I said ... there ain't nothing sexier than a man with a book. School District Apologizes to Gay Student After Blacking Out Photo of Male Kiss

A New Jersey school superintendent was forced to personally apologize to a gay high school senior after she ordered staff to "black out" a yearbook photo showing him kissing his boyfriend.



Newark School District Superintendent Marion A. Bolden showed up at the graduation rehearsal at East Side High School and was introduced to 18-year-old Andre Jackson. In front of the graduating class, Bolden presented a personal apology for redacting the yearbooks. The personal apology came a full day after the school district issued an apology through a press release to the media.

In late June, Jackson attended his senior banquet and was excited to collect his yearbook. He'd paid an additional \$150 for the special tribute page filled with shots of boyfriend David Escobales, 19, of Allentown, Pa., and others. Jackson learned what happened to his page only moments before the books were distributed. While the students waited, staff members in another room blacked out the 4 1/2-by-5-inch picture from approximately 230 books.

Bolden said the picture seemed "illicit" to her although The New York Times reports the yearbook "also included pages with pictures of heterosexual couples kissing."

I didn't intend to say, "hey, look at me, I'm gay," Jackson tearfully told reporters. "It was just a picture showing my emotion, saying that I'm happy, you know, whatever. It was to look back on as a memory...I was upset. I was hurt. I felt embarrassed and abused."

Andre Jackson said the yearbook incident revived tensions with members of his family he has quarreled with because he is gay. Jackson says he came out when he was 16 and that he and Escobales have been together since October 2006.

The school district will distribute un-redacted yearbooks and has agreed to meet on a regular basis with leaders of Newark's LGBT community.

The Evolution of ROBIN THICKE

The New Face of Soul

Soul music has made a return in 2006, with an unexpected face attached with it. Robin Thicke is blue-eyed soul defined on his latest release, *The Evolution of Robin Thicke*. It is, indeed, an evolution. He is no longer known just by his surname as he was for his major-label debut, *A Beautiful World*. His new look has people paying more close attention to him and his music. He wears his hair closely cropped, instead of to his shoulders, to show off his playboy-like good looks. And Thicke, the son of Alan Thicke, the star of the 1980s sitcom *Growing Pains*, shows here that he is his own man. Thicke explains what his sophomore album really means.

"It really has to do with the last two years of my life and about all the crap I went through," Thicke said. "And I feel like when I started writing it, it was all about me, but when I finished writing it, I realized it has to do with all of us, because it's really about a person who's trying to learn from his mistakes and overcome obstacles. Things we all go through."

Thicke, who's currently on tour with India Arie, made his breakthrough with his first single "When I Get You Alone" from *A Beautiful World*. But with *The Evolution of Robin Thicke*, Thicke has recovered well with a sophisticated and self-assured style. His sophomore album, he says, has been a journey to gain confidence.

"For the first album I didn't have the confidence in myself as a physical entity that I did as a musical one," he said. "So I think when my first album came out there was a lot of judging and insecurities that came up. But it ended up being great material for the new album. And you know, that's what some of my songs are about, about appreciating the hard times and the breakdowns and realizing that sometimes that's where you get to clear up your goals and focus on what you really want."

There's no doubt that Thicke is blessed with the falsetto that has echoes of Marvin Gaye, a gift he puts to use on some of the notably rich-boy-blues track "Cocaine" and the classic soul-leaning "Got 2 Be Down." But Thicke explains that the new album is more about tackling some of his own inner demons.

"The new album is very much about tackling demons and drugs and temptations, and trying to get through your insecurities and love yourself and enjoy life," he said. "I definitely had a rough time over the last year. Life is full of constant ups and downs, and all I ask for is redemption in the end."

Rumors around town are saying that Robin Thicke is taking a page from the Justin Timberlake manual of "blue-eyed" soul for the new

millennium. Thicke says that he didn't look to Timberlake for inspiration. But with help from The Neptunes' Pharrell Williams, Thicke blends the old and the new into a smooth, laid-back sound that gives "The Evolution of Robin Thicke" an urban sheen.

"Oh, immediately Pharrell and I hit it off. I mean we immediately had a lot of things in common," Thicke said. "We're both artists, we're both producers, we're both songwriters, and he plays, he writes songs on the piano and keyboard and guitar, and so do I. You know, so there was a lot of camaraderie and an immediate understanding for each other's creative process, and, you know, he gives me space to create the music that I want to create, and when he was helping me I gave him space to be the genius he is. You don't walk in the room with Pharrell and tell him how to do his job."

Thicke crafts songs infused with a lust for love and sex, with songs like, "Teach U A Lesson" which has sexy and just plain naughty undertones. On songs such as "Complicated," he appears vulnerable, exposing his flaws and hoping that the woman who sees them will still love him. His second single, "Lost Without You," showcases guitar riffs and intimacy.

Thicke is an impressive singer-songwriter in his own right and he has vocals that are sure to make your drawers fall (way) down. And the best part is that he makes it all sound really good.

"My music has always been very pure, and my goal has always been to look further inside and not at what other people are doing," he said. "And my goal for this album, my only goal for this album was to pretend that there were no other artists, there were no other musicians, and what would I write and what would I do if it just poured out of my heart, if I just opened my mouth and sang, what would happen? You know, as opposed to, 'Oh, I got to be different,' or, 'This other guy just did that kind of a song.' And if I just said, 'Fuck all that. Let me just see what comes out of my heart,' you know? And it ended up being the most pure music I've made."

SIDEBAR: Some of Thicke's accolades include: He has written and produced for many performers, including Christina Aguilera, Jordan Knight, Usher, Mary J. Blige and Michael Jackson. But lately, he's become known for his single with Pharrell Williams called "Wanna Love You Girl."

good girl gone bad

It seems like you can't go anywhere this summer without hearing Rihanna's "Umbrella." The track is an instant classic announcing its arrival with a fierce verse from Jay-Z before the Caribbean queen's nasal yet pleasant voice rides a thick yet slowed down groove. In just a few short years Barbadian born Rihanna has released three albums with hits ranging from the dancehall-lite of "Pon De Replay" to the disco anthem "SOS." Her latest release, the sizzling Good Girl Gone Bad, finds the diva in training sexing up her image and taking control of her career. "Umbrella" is a major step forward for this artist, catapulting her into the same lexicon as the Beyonces and Ciaras of the world. Rihanna is now one to watch and rest assured she has our attention.

Where Rihanna's previous albums relied heavily on Caribbean references and boring ballads, Good Girl Gone Bad takes on a new direction, supported by trailblazing club anthems and major collaborators like Timbaland, Ne-Yo and Justin Timberlake. The end result is Rihanna's finest work to date and as good a bid as any for major international success. She does seem to cover all the bases in an attempt to appeal to a wide range of listeners. She has the electro club beats on lock with "Push Up On Me." The gay white boys are sure to go nuts over "Don't Stop The Music" with its pounding bass and sexy lyrics. Timbaland fans will be pleased with his work here, most notably on "Lemme Get That," a science fiction reggae hybrid that finds Rihanna playing the sexy vamp. Man of the moment Ne-Yo shows up a few times on the album and although his contributions sound a bit too much like Beyonce's "Irreplaceable," they still go down smoothly. Justin Timberlake penned the track titled "Rehab" and even though it's nowhere near as compelling as the Amy Winehouse song of the same name, it is a solid attempt at creating a more adult persona around Rihanna. In fact, most of Good Girl Gone Bad is structured around giving the singer a more mature vibe. Tracks like "Breakin Dishes" and "Shut Up and Drive" are pure pop, to be sure, but they do display a level of maturity and adventurous that was missing from the artist's previous material. The reggae vibes that dominated her older work is only hinted at. The track "Say It" prominently samples the classic song "Flex" (Time to have sex).

So after three albums Rihanna moves away from the dancehall grooves that she was originally known for and embraces a more adventurous sound. With the success of "Umbrella" it appears that the gamble is paying off. There are enough cuts on Good Girl Gone Bad to satisfy a variety of fans and possibly convert a few new ones

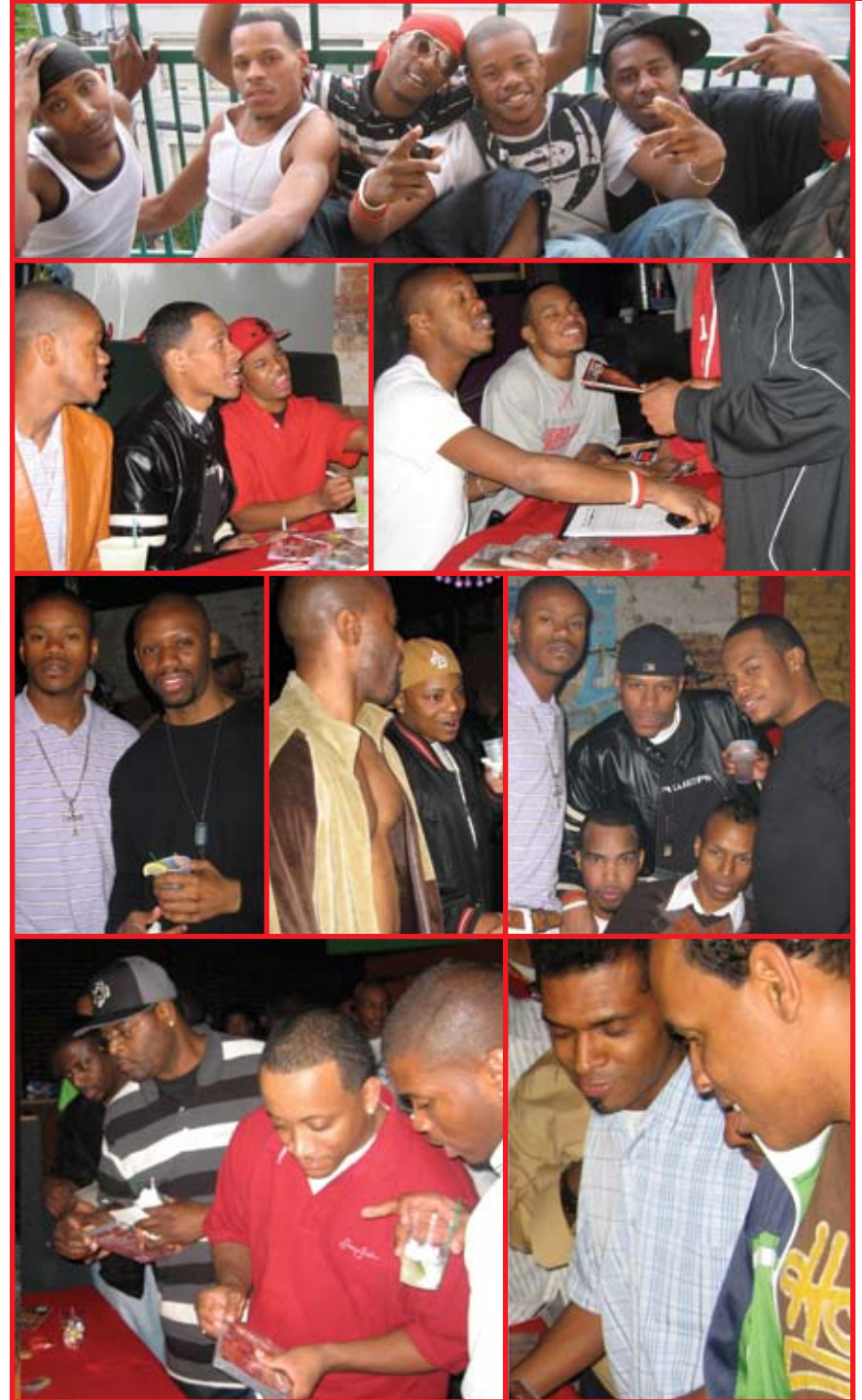

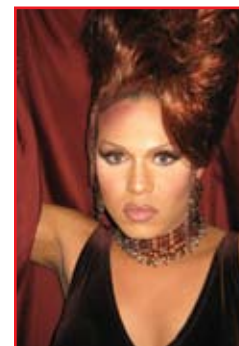

HIP & POP & LEARN & LOVE

What do I – a nearly middle-aged white man from the suburbs – know of Hip-Hop culture to be interviewing the creative force behind HipandPop.com? I mean, seriously, when I first heard the word ‘bling’ I thought it was the sound elevators make just before their doors opened. But when Russell Simmons, widely considered to be the father of the Hip-Hop movement, speaking to Oprah’s audience in her two-day, town hall meeting on the firing of Don Imus, reminded us that Hip-Hop is not just a musical style but a culture, I had my own ‘Ah-Ha’ moment. It allowed me to appreciate the subject of this interview in a wholly different light because in order to understand it I needed to embrace it like I would any culture I wanted to learn more about.. And even though Mr. Simmons did not elaborate on just what defined either the parameters of that culture or what lay within, there is, in fact, a vibrant urban framework in which Hip-Hop culture can be identified.

HipandPop.com is one marker along this cultural arc. It is a carnival of hip hop and pop culture and Godspell (a.k.a. Greg Curtis) is the Barker. His breezy, good-humored tone coupled with his journalist’s sense of newsworthiness make HipandPop.com a must read. I had a chance to talk with Godspell recently and was struck and how one Loyola College student’s vision has foisted a new kind of Hip-Hop sensibility on American culture.

You seem to have had a large following from the get-go. One of your first posts has almost one hundred comments! Can you explain how you were poised for success from the beginning or do you think these are comments that have accumulated over the months?

Honestly, I can’t even believe that the site has grown so big. Who knew that people would even care to read what I have to say. Most of the comments have accumulated over time though. Mainly, through constant updates and sharing too other sites with exclusive stuff that flies across my desktop.

How did your staff form? Did everyone know each prior to the project? Did everyone come to the table knowing what it was they wanted to do for Hip and Pop? Talk a little bit about its genesis. Also, does your staff work full-time on the project? Are you hiring?

Well, Jane B. (the editor-in-chief) hired me. I knew Jane before Hipandpop.com. [But] there was never really a round table discussion. Jane kind of opened the project and eventually [it] just came into play. I’m basically the one running the site now. I’m full-time and unfortunately we aren’t hiring. People are still welcomed to send in applications and talk to us...you never know.

Explain ‘Hip and Pop, scream and smile’ to readers who may be unfamiliar with your site. Could you do it in four words if that were the sort of world we lived in?

I HAVEN’T A CLUE!!! LOL, it just came across while designing the site. We are supposed to be fun and a little bit more edgy compared to other blogs. We try to give rising artists a stepping-stone as well as shock the audience. Hell, we posted the Kim Kardashian Sex tape on our site...We really try to add numerous flavors to give our site numerous audiences.

How do you go about getting your interview with the singers that you do? What criteria do you use? Talk a little bit about your first interview with Pretty Ricky. How did that come about?

We mostly just get offers from label representatives. We have no criteria. We’ll interview anyone. OMG, the Pretty Ricky interview. My friend Amy did the interview while on our shuttle bus for Loyola University of Chicago. She literally did the interview from the top of her head. They were in a rush so she squeezed just enough info out and I did a good job editing the audio. Overall, we were pleased with the product but it was hectic during the actual process.

You may be the only blog we know of that has an L.A. number to call if you have any questions. Do you really return calls? Or is it faster to email?

We’ll, I’m not in charge of the L.A. number to call. However, you are welcome to call the Chicago number. 312-324-3308. I return all phone calls. Email is good, too, but busy bee that’s me.

Spend a minute on the tone of the site. You’ve got a unique voice. Do you feel it represents a new generation or is it simply the give and take between a staff that obviously works very well together.

The tone of the site is not to neglect any audience. Period. Everyone should have a voice. We try hard to incorporate tons of people in the site somehow, some way.

Where are you headed stylistically? Editorially?

Not sure...We need a new layout. I’ll probably make that or hire someone. Editorially, more posts. The more content the merrier. ThatKid.org will be opening soon and we’ll be branching into that direction to help spin into more of a video blog setting for myself. It should be rather entertaining.

Your site is a bit of an assault on the senses for a first time visitor. Any comment?

Good. We want them to be scared:-P

How would you rank yourself in terms of status? Are you the go-to crew on Hip Hop/Pop culture?

I didn’t even think we had status but thanks for even giving us that much credibility.

BLOGS THAT MATER (PART 3)

(Disclaimer: I will not discuss blogs written by writers appearing in FlavaLife.)

This is the third installment of my ongoing series on blogs. In part one, I introduced you, the reader, to what a blog is and what forces were at work to make this particular style of writing so popular today. I also wrote about three blogs that distinguished themselves from the pack. In part two, we took a look at the different styles of blogging and I introduced you to three more blogs. In this article we will discuss how to get your blog out there so people will actually read it.

One of the first things you have to be able to do – aside from be able to write well - is let people know you are out there. One common way: Exchange links with other bloggers. Commonly known as “blogrolls,” these are outbound links listed on your site to other sites that you like. (Hint: Spend some time reading the site you wish to link to before hitting them up with favors. Post comments. There’s nothing I hate more than when someone asks to link up with me and I find out that their blog is devoting mostly to white models. My blog is called MEN OF COLOR. Hello? You’ve given me nothing to suggest my readers would enjoy what you have to offer.) Another thing you can do is embed your posts with a lot of links. I mean don’t go hog wild but there’s a good chance that the person receiving your link will see that it came from you and might just extend a link exchange invitation to you. There are also a quattillion blog aggregating sites that you can register with such as Technorati (www.technorati.com) or Bloglines (www.bloglines.com), vehicles that identify, categorize and rank blogs.

With that said, here are three more blogs worthy of your time and consideration.

NAKEDCAMEI

With an understanding and depth of knowledge rivaled only by Wikipedia, Nakedcamei is without a doubt one of the well-written blogs. Period. The subtitle to this blog is “Gay porn, gay male nude photography, movies, politics, the labor movement and Washington, D.C. Just the usual shit.” But there’s nothing usual about the writing, the subject matter or the hot photos he posts on a regular basis. On any given day, you might read a fascinating analysis of an episode of ‘Battleship Galactica,’ a thorough and moving tribute to an Adult Industry insider or the trials and tribulations of its author. Behind his profound intellect, there is a sense of humanity and compassion that belies his critical faculties. And then there are the photos. Nakedcamei is a huge fan of men of color especially well-endowed men of color. So if the loftier side of this blog should be too much for you, you can always rely on the more prurient interests of this talented and well-established blogger.

I can’t go home again until I “get over this gay thing”; so my mom says. Fine; that place is more depressing than making Nikes for two cents an hour. And high school friends I consciously haven’t spoken to in over eight years are making ardent strides to get all up in my Kool-Aid. Is there some way I can tactfully tell these people to just leave me the hell alone so’s I can live my life?” Honest. Raw. Affecting. These are the basic building blocks of his narrative and as Karsh wryly notes, “I got the power. Now what?” Karsh, just keep doing what you’re doing. That’s your power.

RICHARD ANTHONY

The man behind the cover of the July/August issue of FlavaLife - Richard Anthony - has all the sexiness, confidence, and charm in his photos that you'd expect; a straight dude from the City of Brothaly Love; on da surface, Richard's a real ladies man with da face and body to back it up.

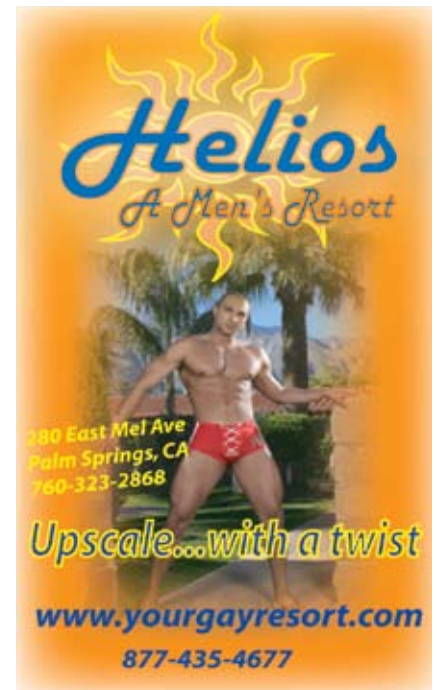

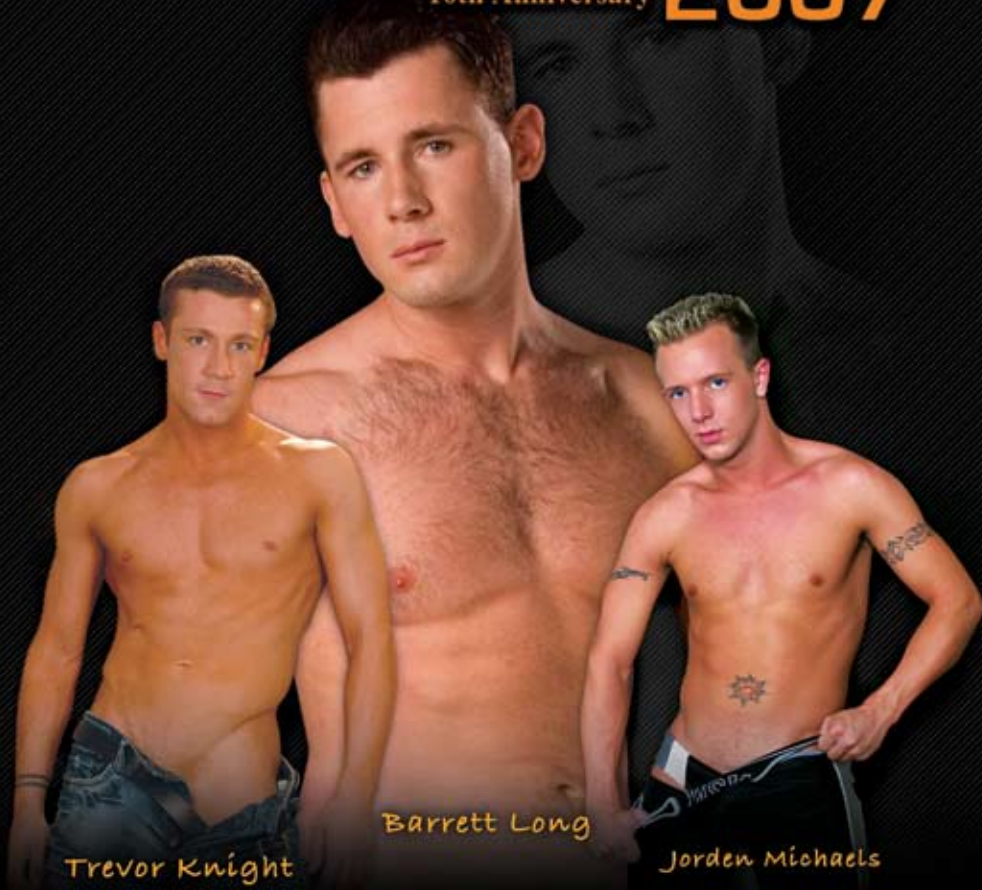

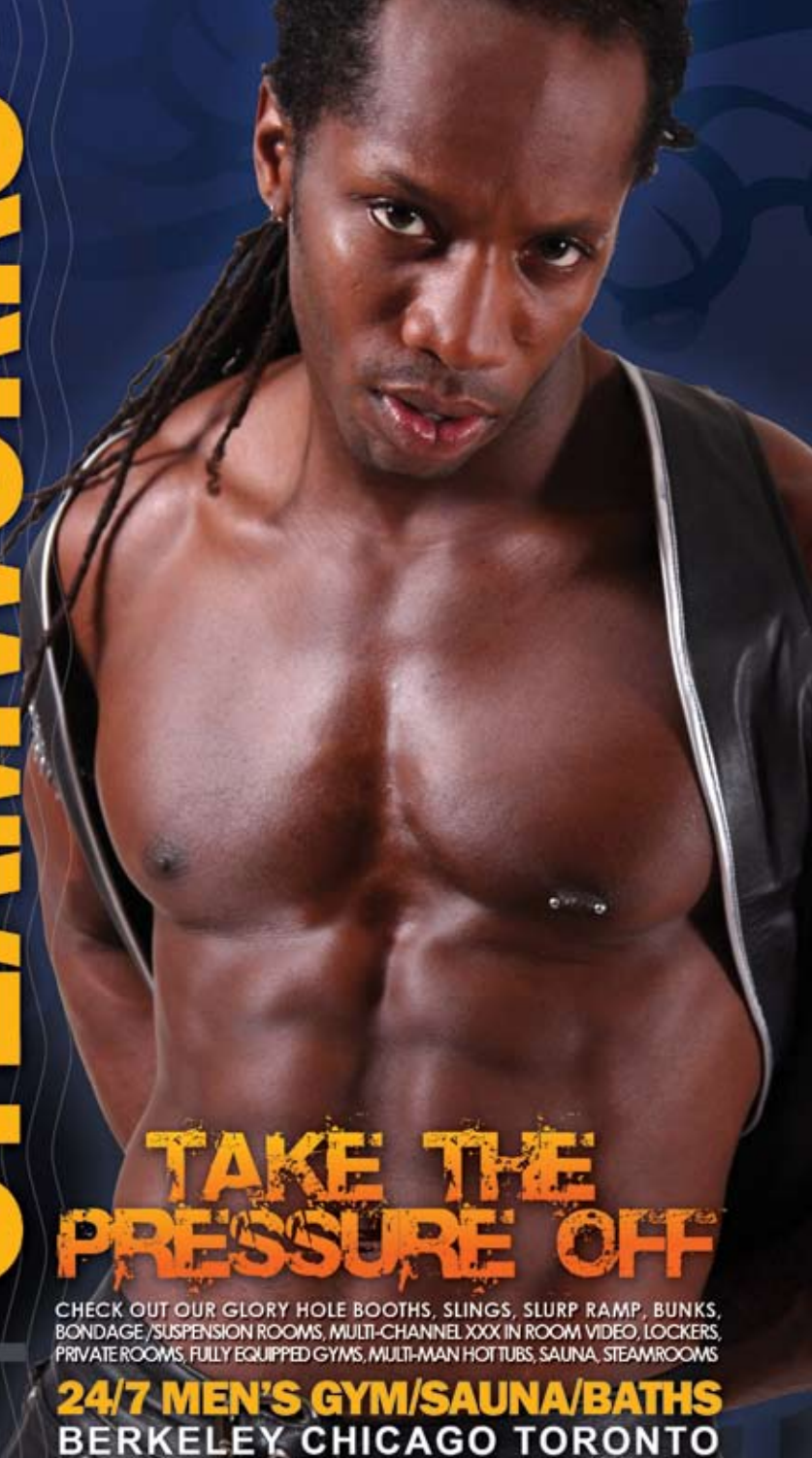
