But relationships aren't for everyone. These days there are a lot of happy single men out there and they just enjoy casual dating. Find-



Deondray Gossett

Delpano Wills

One of the strongest films of the summer-fall independent film festival circuit has been the short film On the Low. It's a true short-only 15:29 minutes-but what it lacks in length the film more than makes up in delivery and subject material. Why? On the Low chronicles two high school boys who fall in love and begin a "down low" relationship.

The movie centers around young Ty Evans (Deondray Gossett) who attempts to come to terms with feelings he has for his classmates. His male classmates-specifically his buddy Kevin Banks (Delpano Wills). The two engage in brief experimentation, which leads to, well, more experimentation ... and then a schoolyard fight. As the sexual tension escalates, Ty begins to realize that what began as innocent curiosity has now blossomed into something much more profound. Confused, Ty seeks the advice of Mr. Davis, a teacher and mentor figure. The older man has some very succinct and wise advice for the boy: follow your heart.

For a short film, On the Low has some decent star wattage, boasting Martin's Tommy Ford as Mr. Davis. Young actors Deondray Gossett of Parenthood and Sister Act 2 and Delpano Wills of DarkTown are also industry veterans. On the Low was written and directed by Luther Mace, a producer/writer type who formerly crewed at Living Single and Martin. It was at the latter sitcom where he met Tommy Ford, who immortalized the character of Martin's sidekick. Luther Mace obtained a waiver from the Screen Actors Guild to make the experimental film, and then approached the sitcom star. Recently,



Mace talked with FlavaLife from his Los Angeles offices. "Tommy had some initial questions; his concern was that his character wasn't just a sounding board. Once we addressed those character points, he was on board. I'm glad that we did. His scene is so poignant."

Ty's conversation with his teacher is one of the best-written scenes in the film; but the stand out scene of the film has very few lines. That's the first long, tender kiss enjoyed by Ty and Kevin. It comes across as oh-so-natural, but the director says the talent practiced three times-with tongue-until they achieved the desired affect. "Their scene had gentleness ... a tenderness. It was just lovely the way that Deondray stroked Del's head. This was the first time that the characters kissed. It was more like ... wonder. They didn't know what to expect."

Apparently, Deondray Gossett was no stranger to the same-sex kiss on film. The director says the actor's "reel" — a short collection of his work on a tape, like a video resume-also included another gay kiss. "Well, at least we knew that he wouldn't be afraid to do what the role required. Later, when I took his tape home ... it was remarkable. I saw the tape and immediately he became Ty Evans. I knew that if his acting encouraged that sort of visceral response, he was the one."

Luther Mace began writing On the Low in October 2003. He says it took several months to write, but he was in production by August 2004. The budget was extremely modest—"about six thousand bucks" - mostly self-financed. So far, the film has been a hit. On the Low has been invited to or screened at 22 film festivals. The big question: will he follow up with a feature?

"I'm trying to," the screenwriter-director says. By day he works in administration at HBO, and his 9 to 5 has put some constraints on his time. But he's actively scripting a full-length feature; hopefully an independent studio will greenlight the project. But the basic story will not change. "On the Low is a coming of age film, and would remain as such," the director insists. "There's always a temptation to try something different, or try to make more money or maximize box office. But I feel like, this is the film the audiences responded to. If they enjoyed what they saw, let me give them more of what they appreciated to begin with."

WHEN WORLDS

COLIDE REVIWED BY

We've seen the new millennium usher in a black gay renaissance. Blogstars such as Keith Boykin and Jasmyne Cannick are making news and headlines around the world. Noah's Arc is on television, Punks and On the Low are on the big screen, and the bookshelves are overflowing with new titles. When Worlds Collide is part of that new literary explosion; it's one of the latest novels to explore the black gay experience, but the perspective is much different than the traditional, American black gay experience. The book relates the story of a gay black man born in the Bahamas, who journeys to Britain and later America to discover life and love. He develops

a unique and lasting bond with two other people from very different backgrounds, whose worlds collide in England in the late 1980's.

This is the first novel of Bahamian-born Shawn Forbes, and already we're impressed. The main reason is that the novel is layered-it's not your usual three or four gay men living in New York City or Los Angeles, each with a fabulous career-but no romantic prospects. Sure, they are similarities to traditional coming of age stories; Worlds is also built around three friends, but there's a major difference. One is black, another is South Asian and the third ... is a white, Canadian woman. "Almost from

the moment that I started writing, I realized that although the central theme was to surround the two gay men, I did not want it to be an exclusively gay novel, "Forbes recently said during an interview from his home in Nassau. "I wanted to weave a human story against the backdrop of the gay theme. I wanted the potential reader—regardless of gender, sexuality or race—to find a bit of him/herself in the characters."

The setting is the late 1980s. Our protagonist is Stephen Taylor, a young Bahamian who has always had a strained relationship with his church-going family. He travels to Manchester, England for studies and meets Suresh Patel, a fellow student at the University of Manchester. Suresh is everything that Stephen is not; while Stephen is closeted, Suresh is out and proud.

Stephen is reserved; Suresh is the witty queen who has always has the best comebacks. "If only everyone had a Suresh!" Shawn remarked in our interview. "He did, said and lived everything that everyone dreams about."

Stephen is a romantic at heart, while Suresh has perfected the art of the lunchtime pick-up. Suresh comes across as brash, bitchy and heartless, but it's all a coping mechanism—like many gay men, he also comes from a volatile family situation. Suresh takes Stephen under his wing, schools him on the nuances of the life. Stephen begins the book as somewhat of a pessimist, as evidenced by this passage early in their friendship when he discusses his prospects as a gay man in the Bahamas:

"Men are supposed to be strong and domineering. It's expected that they'll spend half of their lives conquering women and the other half talking about it with other men. ... Men who don't conform to that view are generally perceived as

weak. The prevailing view of gay men is that they are hip swaying, weak-wrist sissies who all want to be women. I've met a few openly gay men at home. The ones that I have seen are ones that fall into that category. Believe me, their lives are usually made hell."

Ouch. As we say here in the states, Stephen had issues—and his friend-ship with Suresh was the beginning of process to resolve them. Another step in the right direction was the third character, Tanya Collings. Tanya grew up in Canada's maritime provinces—Nova Scotia Prince

Edward Island—and eventually made her way to the University of Manchester. Naturally, she is neither a man nor gay so your first inclination may be to skip over her sections. No. You won't be able to because Tanya's own personal background is quite touching; she suffered unspeakable horrors by her parents, and eventually escaped, albeit with physical and mental scars. But her strength and resolve are admirable, as well as her beauty. Suresh is the glue that binds the delicate balance of their collective friendship: unfortunately, he later becomes HIV positive and must fight for his life. After a long battle, Suresh succumbs to AIDS-and his death drives Tanya and Stephen apart, when they should be close.

Stephen's life takes a few major turns. He runs away from a pro basketball player who is in love with him. He returns to the Bahamas and




tries to live a "normal life", even marrying Evelyn, a woman who has loved him for years, but he does not feel the same. Eventually, family tragedy sends Stephen over the edge and he suffers a complete nervous breakdown. Even though Suresh was the drama

queen of the trio, we wonder, is Stephen making his own life worst? Stephen's life does improve after he decides to master his own fate. We won't give away the ending, but everyone's issues are resolved with supreme satisfaction—as well as several surprises.

When Worlds Collide is not the product of the typical avenue chosen by many authors, such as teaching, journalism, or a background in the arts or entertainment. Shawn Forbes has a fascinating and personal story—the thirtysomething novelist is a successful lawyer and banker. He studied at the University of Manchester, and later returned to Nassau to embark on successful career as a litigator, trust officer and banker. His life has just a few similarities to his main character, but that's it.


It's obvious that we like When Worlds Collide. But nothing is perfect—especially a first novel. At 500 plus pages, it's a long story and not for light reading. But there are advantages of reading longer books during these cooler fall and winter months. This would be the perfect read to share with a mug of hot cocoa or tea, or curled under the cover with that special someone.

So ... Beauty has a Beast, after all. Envy aside, this is indeed sad news for us. But when we tell Carlos so, he laughs his deep, husky laugh again.

"Never say never, bro. For real. Take this magazine shoot, for instance. I told ya all I would never do all nude, but when that camera was clicking for this I was getting so turned on, now I'm thinkin' about it. Like it might not be a bad idea, after all."

Whoa. And if the girlfriend finds out? Or worse yet – objects?

"Hey, I'm a man, ya know? No female dictates what I do." Carlos shrugs again as he adds, "Besides, she's happy if she knows I'm happy."

Wow. You'd have to give out vouchers for that line - for sure!







Black Gay Greeting Cards Challenge Lack of Diversity and Visibility



Lavenderpop was created to confront the lack of diversity among the major greeting card companies as well as smaller gay themed card lines. "The few gay cards I would see at specialty shops have virtually no people of color images." says Otis Richardson the owner and artist of the twenty card line. "I wanted to create a line that represented this influential but overlooked community. I've spoken to many store managers who've told me how hard it is to find quality Black greeting cards." Otis adds, "Lavenderpop also serves to enhance our relationships and friendships. People in our community are thrilled to send and receive cards that look like us."


Richardson chose to focus on everyday type cards instead of specific holidays. The cards cover such categories as Happy Birthday, Romance, Diva Humor, and Get Well. More specialty cards include HIV awareness, Youth and Bi pride. Launched in August of 2004, the cards are now carried in 12 stores in 6 cities. In Chicago: Women and Children First, Cupid's Treasure, Ragin' RaeJean's Gifts & Stuff, Yera's Lakeview Florist, and Open Door Books Et Cetera. Philadelphia: Giovanni's Room. Nashville: OUTLOUD Books & Gifts. Washington DC: Pulp, Pulp on the Hill, and Lambda Rising. Baltimore: Lambda Rising. Ferndale: Just 4 Us. They can also be purchased online at www.lavenderpop.com.

For many years there has been a cultural maturity among Black gays. This is evident in the proliferation of Black gay literature, magazines, independent movies, social and internet groups, and Black Pride celebrations

Lavenderpop Greeting Cards satisfy a niche group, but also has broad appeal. Although the cards were created for the Black Igbt community, many of the styles are relatable regardless of race or sexual orientation. Otis states "I created a card titled 'They Call These Divas?' It's intended to be sent to anyone who has a real diva attitude. It doesn't matter if they're Black, white, Latin, female, male, gay, or straight. It's a fun card that crosses all lines."


